Neighborhood Dues Assessment Coming Soon


Each January we all receive a notice that our annual subdivision dues are due and payable. Watch for your billing to arrive at the end of the month. For many years in the past, our annual dues were one-hundred dollars. This year, dues remain at \$75. Many other associations pay much more.

These dues are necessary to cover the unavoidable costs of operating our homeowners' association, including the costs of maintaining our "common areas", such as our entranceways. Some assets must be set aside for legal fees should our association ever be involved in court proceedings.

We think that the dues are a reasonable and decent investment that will enhance the value of our properties over the long term.

Admittedly, in the past, a very few residents failed to submit their dues. Everyone needs to understand that unpaid dues become a lien on our own property, which means they are paid in full at the time we sell our home. This means that all homeowners do pay all of their dues, either in little annual amounts, or all at once when they sell their home.

Please send in your dues in a timely manner. We thank you for doing so.
