Win a chance to have FREE 2019 dues!


At this meeting, we will have a raffle for those in attendance and the winner will have his/her 2019 HOA dues paid by the Association!

home improvements? Considering a deck or any other outdoor structure or addition of any kind? Such exterior improvements are

ALL subject to the regulations and restrictions of our homeowners' association covenant. Each project must be approved by the HOA Architectural Committee <u>before construction can legally begin</u>.

This is a serious requirement of our Association's covenant—a legally binding document that has the same authority as a township ordinance or state law. In fact, the Association has the legal authority to require any project that has NOT received HOA approval to be disassembled and removed.
